White House Budget Proposals Slash Postal Workers' Pay and Benefits

"Robbing workers to pay the rich, this budget is Robin Hood in reverse."

URGENT

- Calls for an increase of 6% employee pension contributions into the Federal Employee Retirement System (FERS) 1% a year for each of the next six years. This would result in a pay-cut of thousands of dollars a year for each FERS postal employee.
- Eliminates Cost of Living Adjustments (COLA) on FERS retirement benefits and reduces COLA on current civil service retirees. Changes how future retirement benefits are calculated (CSRS and FERS) by switching from "high three" average to a "high five" year formula.
- Advocates doing away with the Social Security supplement currently covering the gap in FERS benefits for those who retire before they are eligible for social security benefits.

- Contains massive cuts to Social Security disability benefits, Medicaid coverage, the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and the student loan program.
- Proposes \$46 billion in "savings" to the Postal Service by a reduction in the methods of delivery.
- All of these cuts finance an enormous tax break to corporate America and the wealthy elite.
