Pat Davis Scholarship

The requirements for one of the two \$750.00 scholarships are listed below. Completed applications must be received no later than the second Sunday in June of the year applied for. You may pick up, call and request an application with rules and regulations be sent to you, &/or download it from our website. **REMEMBER ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN THE SECOND SUNDAY IN JUNE FOR CONSIDERATION. Completed applications can be mailed to "The Scholarship Committee, Dallas Area Local, APWU, 2010 Postal Way, Dallas, TX 75212. You can also walk in your application within the time limit specified.**

Requirements for High School Seniors

- The requirements for High School Seniors is; that the person be a child or legal guardian of a member in good standing (1 Year or more) of the American Postal Workers Union , Dallas Area Local, and a High School Senior. They must have taken the "SAT" Test or the "ACT" Test and these scores must be submitted with a recommendation from you High School Counselor or Principle, along with your Transcript. The student is responsible for submitting all the required information with the application. Your application will not be considered without this information.

Anti-Discrimination Clause

- This scholarship is available to all qualified High School Students whose parent (s) are members in good standing, regardless of sex, race, religion or ethnic background and no scholarship administered by the Scholarship Fund will disqualify any applicant on these grounds. Scholarship money must be used to obtain and undergraduate degree.

Deadline for Entry

- The deadline is **THE SECOND SUNDAY IN JUNE OF THE YEAR APPLIED.** The scholarship will be awarded at the regular scheduled Union Meeting in October. Award recipients, ***if possible***, are expected to be present for pictures to include in the Local's Newspaper and/or on the Dallas Area Local Website.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR
PAT DAVIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

- Applicant must be a son or daughter of an active or deceased member of the American Postal Workers Union.
- Applicant parent (s) must have been a member of APWU, Dallas Area Local in good standing for a total of at least one year.
- Applicant must be a senior a senior attending high school or other corresponding secondary school.
- Scholarship recipient must attend an accredited college of his or her choice. Applicant must make own application to the college.
- Applications for scholarship must be made on an official application form. Completed application forms ***must be sent and received*** to the Pat Davis Scholarship Program, at, 2010 Postal Way, Dallas, TX 75212 **by the last Friday in May of the Graduation Year!**
- All applicants must take the **Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT** College board) or the **American College Test (ACT** College Board).
- **All Secondary School Repots, SAT or ACT** scores must be post marked no later that of the Graduation year. The Counselor or Principle's recommendations must be with the package to be considered.
- Scholarship must be used towards pursuing an undergraduate degree.

- If the award winner fails to attend college in the award year, the award will go to an alternate.
- Winners will be judged on the basis of their secondary school records, personal qualifications, and the results of **Scholastic Aptitude Test** or **American College Test**.
- The Scholarship Selection committee will consist of two APWU Officers. No person connected with the American Postal Workers Union will make the final decision.
- The Pat Davis Memorial Scholarship will be two, one time awards worth \$750.00 each.
- The amount of the Scholarship will be awarded on the third Sunday of the month of October in the year applied at 2:00 p.m. at the regular scheduled meeting of the Local. These rules will be adhered to unless something unforeseen occurs with the applicant or the Local Scholarship Committee.
